

**BYLAWS  
PINELLAS COUNTY BAIL BOND ASSOCIATION**

**ARTICLE I  
NAME AND LOCATION**

The name of this nonprofit professional association is Pinellas County Bail Bond Association, hereinafter referred to as the Association. The geographic boundaries include Greater Pinellas County, Florida. All meetings shall be held within the boundaries of the Association. If a boundary dispute occurs, the Board of Directors will decide the boundary lines. The mailing address of the Association shall be the current mailing address of the president or other address designated by the Association Board of Directors.

**ARTICLE II  
OBJECTIVES AND PURPOSES**

Subject to the specific, primary and general purposes stated in the Articles of incorporation and as a supplement thereto the objectives and purposes of the Association are:

- (a) To do all things appropriate to the development, maintenance and advancement of high standards in the art, science and skills of bail bonding; to encourage, establish and maintain high standards of bail bonding education and training for the bail bondsman.
- (b) To promote general awareness of the field of bail bonding.
- (c) To gather, publish and disseminate information pertinent to the growth, development and improvement in the skills of bail bonding.
- (d) To affiliate, cooperate and work with and obtain professional recognition from other bail bonding societies and other agencies, professionals and associations in the judicial field.
- (e) To encourage, define, establish and enunciate high standards of education and training for bail bondsmen and to implement these standards of education and training through appropriate channels, including cooperating and working with public and private schools and colleges which offer training and education in the field of bail bonding.
- (f) To stimulate and encourage research concerning the knowledge needed to enhance the performance of the bail bond industry and the sociological, environmental and legal issues related thereto.
